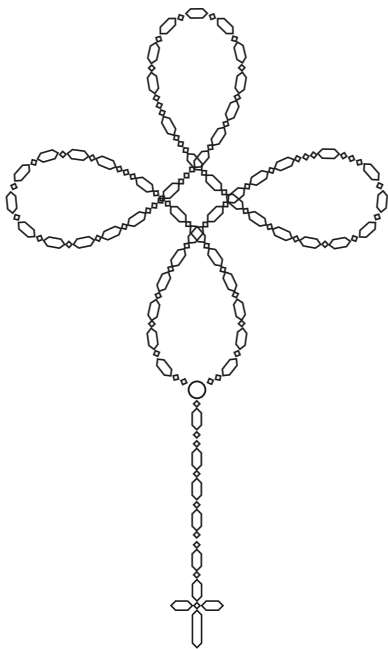

THE JOYFUL MYSTERIES

I

The Annunciation

It is for the love of you that I have come down from Heaven, too; for the love of you I lived, for you I died, and for you I have created the heavens (D 853).

II

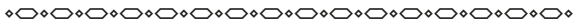
The Visitation

Don't worry about what other people are doing, you just do as I say; you are to be a living reflection of Me through love and mercy (D 1446).

III

The Birth of Our Lord

Although My greatness is infinite, yet I abide only with those who are little. I require you to have the spirit of a child (D 332).





IV

The Presentation in the Temple

You shall unite your prayers, fasts, mortifications, works, and all your sufferings with My prayer, fasting, mortifications, work, and suffering; then they will be powerful in the eyes of My Father (D 531).

V

The Finding of Jesus in the Temple

It is for souls like yours that I am searching and longing, but there are few of them; your great trust is forcing Me to keep granting you graces all the time. You have great and infinite rights to My Heart, for you are an absolutely trusting daughter (D 718).





THE LUMINOUS MYSTERIES

I

The Baptism in the Jordan

You should realise, O My daughter, that if you strive for perfection you will be leading many souls to sanctity; but if you should not strive for sanctity, many souls would thereby remain imperfect. Know that their perfection will depend on your perfection (D 1165).

II

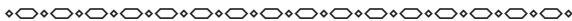
The Wedding Feast of Cana

It will be your duty to trust completely in My goodness, and it will be My duty to give you all that you need. I am making Myself depend on your trustfulness; if your trustfulness is great, there will be no bounds to My generosity (D 548).

III

The Proclamation of the Kingdom of God

Do what is in your power to spread the worship of My mercy; I shall complete whatever is wanting in your capacity. Tell distressed humankind to come up and cling to My Heart, and I shall fill it with peace (D 1074).





IV

The Transfiguration

Why, oh why are you afraid, why do you tremble, if you are united with Me? I am not pleased with a soul if it succumbs to vain fears. Who will dare touch you if you are with Me? Dearest to Me is the soul which firmly believes in My goodness and has put all its trust in Me; I bestow My confidence on it and grant everything it asks for (D 453).

V

The Institution of the Eucharist

Oh, how I am hurt that souls so very rarely unite with Me in Holy Communion. I am waiting for souls to come to Me, but they don't care about Me. I love them sincerely and so very much, but they don't trust Me enough. I want to lavish My graces on them, but they don't want to take them. They treat Me like an inanimate object, though My Heart is full of love and mercy (D 1447).

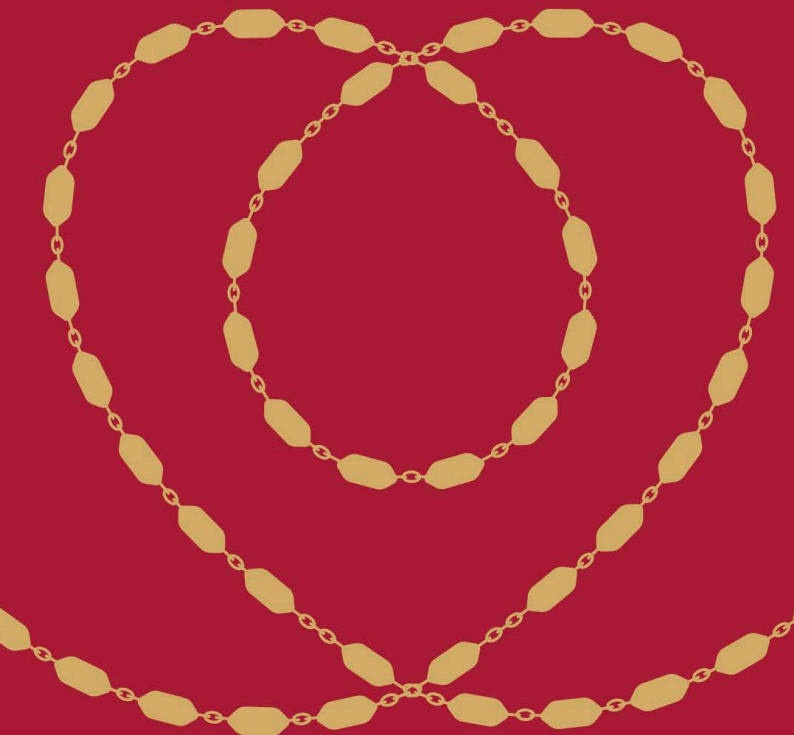
