The First Station
**The Lord Jesus
is Condemned to Death**

Do not be surprised that you are sometimes unjustly accused. I Myself first drank this cup of underserved suffering for love of you (*Diary* 289). Set little store on what people say. Let everyone judge you as they like (*Diary* 1685).



The Second Station
**The Lord Jesus Carries
the Cross on His Shoulders**

Do not be afraid of sufferings;
I am with you (*Diary* 151).
There is but one price
at which souls are bought,
and that is suffering united
to My suffering on the cross.
Pure love understands these
words; carnal love will never
understand them (*Diary* 324).
